## UPDATES FROM THE MANOR

### **Dining Room Christmas Tree**

Once again John Van Wyk Painting, responsible for the excellent painters seen regularly around the Manor, has donated a tree for the dining room, and we always appreciate their generosity in helping make the season bright. Larry, our faithful Santa's Helper already has decorated the tree, and as you can see around the Manor he has begun festooning every available surface everywhere with bright lights and decorations. #### **Annual Fire Inspection**

As Residents may have been aware, the last month has seen much activity around the Manor in order to make our facility compliant with the annual fire inspection and ever changing fire code. Compliance included removing furniture from hallways, removing door stops, completely removing all the combustible storage in the basement parking garage, updating exit signs, and trimming or removing trees whose foliage overhung the various rooftops of the Manor. These changes are mandated by the State fire code and enforced by County Fire Inspectors. Our Executive Director Dan happily reports that we have passed for this year. — Of course, this official compliance is ongoing, and Residents are asked to continue keeping all hallways and stairways free from obstructions of any kind (including chairs or other furniture), and keeping the garage free from any combustible storage. Thanks to all Residents for their patience, understanding and cooperation in making the Manor compliant with Fire Regulations.

#### **Missing Dishes from the Kitchen**

Residents are reminded that dishes, silverware, glasses, and mugs are meant to be left in the Dining Room. Please be aware that your monthly rent payment, part of which is allocated for your dining services, does not mean that anyone owns or is entitled to take bowls or any other kitchen items back to their room. Dishes and other kitchen items are communal and are for everyone to use daily. Recently, dishes have been found in the trash, as if they were disposable, and this is distressing. The way it works is that when people take dishes or silverware of any kind, those items must be replaced so that they can be used by all other residents. It is impossible to stress enough how expensive it is to replace kitchen dishes, silverware and glasses — and when the Kitchen has to replace these items, it means, quite simply, that monthly rents will be increased that much more, impacting all residents, not just those few who abuse the rules and take these items for their personal use. Most Residents abide by the rules and do not take dishes, etc., from the Dining Room, and thanks to all of you. If anyone has dishes stashed, please return them to the dish room to replenish our dwindling supply!
