In order to help facilitate information and personal needs & wants, two bulletin boards are set up for all Residents to reference. One is in the B Lounge and the newest one is in the Laundry Room, both places being in the most heavily used locations at the Manor. Here's how they work, and what each is intended for:

B Lounge Bulletin Boards

The B Lounge bulletin board is for general information and announcements. Betty keeps this up to date and anyone wanting to post anything should go to her so she can keep the postings uniform and easily accessed.



General postings include senior citizen updates and notes from the monthly RSC meetings, among others. Betty updates this bulletin board regularly, so check in often to keep current.

Laundry Room Bulletin Board

This newest bulletin board is intended solely for the purpose of making it easier for Residents to communicate with one other. If you need a ride to an appointment, can offer a ride to others, have furniture or other items to sell or need to buy a lamp or bookcase, or maybe need computer help (or just post a humorous anecdote), the Laundry Room bulletin board is the place to reference.
