MANOR & RSC UPDATE

- We are now under a **Stage 2 Water Alert**, which means it is more important than ever to conserve water. Gardeners Note: Watering is permissible only on Tuesdays and Fridays, and only before 10am and after 4pm!! If watering gets excessive, the faucets will be locked. Please help save water!
- **The A Courtyard is now on a drip system—no hand watering!** The pool area is also on a drip system as well as half of the Promenade and the front of the building. Other areas will hopefully be installed with drip systems as FM budget permits!
- Recently, there has been water flooding in units due to tenant negligence. Any tenant causing water damage or misuse of toilet or sink will result in the cost being charged to the Resident responsible.
- Residents concerned about their liability may wish to obtain Renter’s Insurance, which typically has a low yearly premium.
- Tree trimming and the removal of problematic trees has been underway by gardeners.
- There is no storage on the roof, this has been an issue with certain people. Anything found stored in carts anywhere around the Manor or on the roof will be disposed of immediately.
